Because of your survey contributions, the following changes have been made:

Kept the stops at the hospital and Withrow & College.

Added stops near Patterson Ave and Bishop Circle for access to central campus.

Added stops on College Corner Pike for access to TOPSS.

KEY TAKEAWAYS



Transit use by respondents

- Only 18.2% of respondents do not use public transit in Oxford.
- 40.2% of respondents use public transit 5 to 15 times per week.



Utility of Ditmer parking lot

- Only 11.5% of respondents use the Ditmer parking lot.
- Only 8.9% of respondents use Ditmer parking lot during the day.
- Ditmer parking lot will continue to be served during evenings and weekends.



SafeRide Program

- 19.7% of respondents are NOT familiar with the SafeRide Program.
- BCRTA will work with Miami University to improve communication materials for the SafeRide Program.
- BCRTA and Miami University staff to adjust operating hours of fixed routes service and SafeRide service.
